## Instructions for the KIWANIS CLUB

- 1, Each Kiwanis Club may nominate one High School Senior or College student.
- 2, The student does not have to be a member of a Service Leadership Club.
3. The Club may use any method it desires to select the student to be nominated.
4. Once the student has been selected, the student must complete the official Headland Application Form.
5. The Kiwanis Club Nomination must include the following items:
  - The Students Completed Application.
  - An endorsement letter from the Kiwanis Club which must include:
    - The Kiwanis Club recommendation.
    - An evaluation of the student's character.
    - The student's scholastic record (GPA)
    - Student financial needs (if known)
    - Signature of a Club Officer.
6. All of the items in Number 5 (above) must be delivered to the Headland Committee by March 15.



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## Instructions for the STUDENT

- 1.** You have been selected by a Kiwanis Club as a candidate for a scholarship.
- 2.** You must complete the official Headland Application.
- 3.** Primary criteria used in judging is SERVICE – to your school and community. This is most important and you should be sure to clearly describe your efforts and any responsibilities you had in performing that service. Membership in a Kiwanis sponsored organization is desirable but not required.
- 4.** The selection of the recipients and the amount of the awards will be made by the Headland Scholarship Committee.
- 5.** The Kiwanis Club sponsor will be notified if their nominee is a winner and that winner will be notified by the Kiwanis Club according to their schedule.
- 6.** Congratulations on your nomination and be sure to return the application quickly. The Kiwanis Club must prepare it's endorsement letter and submit the application by March 15.
